



What is **BIDMAS**?

BIDMAS is an acronym used to help remember the order in which multiple calculations should be carried out. This order is known as **ORDER OF OPERATIONS** or **PRECEDENCE**.

Why is order important?

Order is important in many activities. If you put your shoes on before your socks, then your socks could get wet! Calculations that involve multiple operations must be carried out in a specific order.



в	Brackets	Calculations in brackets are done first	for example: (8 - 5)	
1	Indices	Indices and roots come next	for example: 5³ or √16	
D	Division	Division or multiplication are carried out in order from left to right	for example: 8 + 4 × 3	
M	Multiplication		first do 8 + 4, then × 3	
A	Addition	Addition and Subtraction are carried out in order from left to right	for example: 12 - 4 + 2	
S	Subtraction		first do 12 - 4, then + 2
