## FUNDING

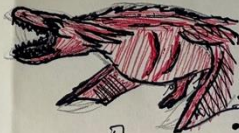
- Tight Budget
- took two and a half years to raise
- Pitching the series was worth \$4.2m to economy
- received funding from Welsh govern ment
- Ffronion factory received development funding of £45,000 and later £500,000

### FUNDING

- £215,000 received by film makers
- 'Friction Factor' £45,000 received and another £500,000
- European Union provide grants
- 'creative europe programme'
- co-production, costs shared + higher production values
- 500,000 euro awarded for the 3rd season
- media antenna wales assisted funding.

### GLOBAL

- Globalisation makes it easier to connect
- International co-production
- Genre is internationally popular
- Worldic war
- Global reach of companies such as Netflix
- HBO
- BBC operates internationally
- Distributed around the world
- Not easily global unlike UK television

### SUCCESS

- Proved that around a dozen EU nations would buy the series
- Sold to at least 12 countries
- 30 territories
- Netflix in USA and Canada
- Raised the profile for wales abroad
- Priming the series in celebration was worth £1.2 million to economy
