



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

#### **English Update:**

#### **English speaking and listening preparation.**

In English lessons all pupils are expected to participate in speaking activities. Speaking and listening skills are assessed as part of GCSE English. These may take the form of a role-play, a presentation/speech, or a group discussion. When they practise at home, you can support in the following ways:

- 1. Encourage them to stand/sit straight and use their hands to emphasise their point.
- 2. Hold any scripts they have and prompt them from this, rather than allowing them to read from the script.
- 3. Talk to them about their tone and pace, e.g. if they are making a serious point their tone should match this.
- 4. Remind them to attempt to look up and engage with their audience when making a speech.
- 5. Ensure they stay in character when performing a role-play or discussion.










#### The Last Mission- Harry Maazer


